The following stipulations govern the content of gty.org for questions of usage, copyright, and permissions:

Audio

We want to maximize your flexibility in sharing the messages while simultaneously maintaining quality control and connecting people with our ministry. Please partner together with us by observing the following guidelines:

You may duplicate and distribute John's audio messages in CD and MP3 format without prior permission as long as you follow the restrictions outlined below.

1. You may duplicate and distribute only full-length versions of the messages.
2. You may not edit the content in any way.
3. You may not charge for the material (even to recoup your costs).
4. You may link to messages at the Grace to You website, but you may not post them on your own website.
5. If you copy material to a CD, please include the following information on the CD:
 - a. The title of the message
 - b. "Copyright [fill in the year of the message] by John MacArthur.

 - c. www.gty.org
 - d. 800-55-GRACE
6. You may not include personal or organizational contact information on any CDs.
7. You may not use or reproduce the Grace to You logo for any purpose.
